BROWN MATERIALS (CARBON)

Leaves
Shredded Straw, Hay
Sawdust
Woodchips + Twigs
Wool
Cereal Boxes
String/Cotton Thread
Ashes from wood
Nut Shells
Shredded Newspaper
Corn Stocks + Cobs
Brown paper bags
Eggshells

PROHIBITED

Fish
Poultry
Bones
Milk Products
Oil
Pet Poop
Glossy Paper
Harsh Chemicals
Weed Seeds
Insect Infected Plants

RATIO

N:C = 2:1

Too much Nitrogen = Smelly Compost

Too much Carbon makes it hard to break down.

LAYERING

Start with a thick drainage layer of twigs.
Then follow the ABCs:

A. Layer of kitchen scraps + GREENS
B. Layer of BROWN
C. Moisten well.
REPEAT

Turn/mix weekly with a garden fork
